BALOO is a one-and-a-half-day course designed as an introduction to the Cub Scout outdoor program for leaders who are interested in adding a camping component to their Pack activities. BSA's Cub Scout level camping policies will be taught along with the discovery of the necessary tools to help units carry out a successful camping experience. Completion of this course is mandatory for A MINIMUM OF ONE adult on a Pack overnigher.

An online component of BALOO training must be completed prior to taking the in-person component. IOLS is a hands-on training program that gives Scouts BSA adult leaders the practical outdoor skills they need to lead Scouts in the outdoors. Upon completion, leaders should feel comfortable teaching Scouts the basic skills required to obtain the First Class rank. Along with Scoutmaster Position-Specific training, this course is required of all Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters to be considered fully trained.
