Please note: Pathways to Scouting—which is for Cub Scout packs—and the Wotamalo Camporee—which is for Boy Scout troops and Venture Crews—run at Camp Wokanda at the same time. This flyer is for Cub Scout packs. The camporee flyer can be downloaded from the W.D. Boyce website calendar.

What's the cost?

The early bird registration cost is \$15 per Cub Scout/Webelos I/Sibling and \$10.00 for any adult if registered before April 3rd (\$20 per person if registered after April 3rd). Please register as a unit. Price includes all program materials and activities for Saturday, an event patch, Saturday supper, and for our newest Boy Scouts, the coveted Wokanda Warrior hat!

Can we camp?

Yes! Upper cabins and valley cabins can be rented through the Peoria Park District (309-579-2157). 30 x 30-foot tent campsites can be reserved for free by emailing Cathy Lane at clane@peoriaparks.org. Your unit can camp Friday (4/17) and/or Saturday (4/18). No ground fires in the tent camping areas. Burn barrels are permitted. Gather firewood from deadwood; or purchase it from the park district; contact the park ranger prior to the event. Ground fires are permitted in cabin fire rings for cabin campers.

Packs, please note...

- Every Lyon and Tiger Cub must have an adult partner. Other Cub Scouts must have one adult walker per three Scouts.
- If Cub Scouts are camping, each Cub Scout must be accompanied by a parent or approved guardian. Follow Guide to Safe Scouting and Youth Protection guidelines.
- Webelos II, whether they have crossed over yet to a troop or not, should participate in Saturday evening's crossover ceremony. Ideally, they should be participating in the Camporee as part of a troop, not with the pack. Encourage your pack to bring these Scouts to be honored.
- The events will proceed rain or shine. Prepare appropriately.
- Bring weather-appropriate clothing. Those attending Saturday evening's ceremony should dress warmly. Those observing the ceremony should bring a camp chair or waterproof cloth for ground seating.
- Everyone should carry drinking water.
- A full dinner (included in your fee) will be provided Saturday night.
- Make arrangements prior to the event to enjoy lunch or cracker barrel with a troop of your choosing. Have fun with the big boys!
- You should wear your field uniform shirt to Saturday evening's ceremony.
- Every participant (Scouts and adults) must complete a Camp Wokanda waiver form (attached). Turn these in at registration.
- No smoking or alcohol is allowed in camp.
- Please register before April 10th as a pack. When you arrive at camp, please send only one person in to registration at the Handicraft Lodge to check in. You may register more individuals at the \$20 rate at that time.
- Parking will be **extremely** limited. Please carpool whenever possible.

How to get to Camp Wokanda

Take Rt. 29 and turn onto Old Galena Road just north of Route 6. Go past Mossville Grade School, turn left on Boy Scout Road and proceed to the park entrance.

Don't forget to complete the attached unit roster/registration form (or register on line at www.wdboyce.org (under Calendar), as well as supply a Camp Wokanda release form (make copies from the form provided with this packet or download form at http://www.peoriaparks.org/liability-waiver-form for every person who will be in camp. Each person must complete a waiver form; turn these in at registration. Registration and fees should be turned in to the Scout office by Friday, April 10, 2020.
